 - 1. **Brian Lee, Town Finance Manager - EV charging station in Harrisburg Park:** Brian will share an overview of the NC VW Rebate approval that was recently secured for the Town in the amount of \$10,000. The SAB will discuss plans on how to promote it - including at the July 4th festival, online (including the PlugShare app), and during National Drive Electric Week (on Sat, 9/25 or 10/2).

Some proposed activities - Set up a booth/tent on Sat & Sun at Harrisburg Park and staff it from 4-8pm each day; include displays (e.g. 1 reusable bottle = 156 plastic bottles annually; reusable to-go bag items; air quality monitoring - PurpleAir & AirBeam2), solar charging for phones, highlight EV charging station, water refilling (?). (Not proposing that SAB members will be in the parade on Sat.)
