- 50th Anniversary Celebration was a wonderful event that really felt like a hometown event. Received lots of great feedback from residents.
- Quarterly Summit – heard from Superintendent Kopicki about plans for new schools as well as trying to reduce the number of mobile units at schools.
- Encouraged residents to attend the community realignment meeting at Hickory Ridge High School on November 29th to hear about the school realignment plans.
- Thanked HBN, Parks and Recreation staff, and the Gathering on Main for a successful Bags in the Burg event.
- This Saturday, Caleb Foster will be holding a canned food and turkey giveaway at Hickory Ridge Middle School. Caleb is a Harrisburg native and now plays basketball for Duke University and wants to give back to his community.

COUNCIL COMMENTS

Councilmember Smith

- Harrisburg Cowboys annual Pink Up added a fundraiser for Breast Cancer this year. They were able to raise approximately \$1,500 and got to present that to Atrium on TV. They plan to do this again next year.

- The football teams did very well this year. Came up a bit short last Saturday, but overall had a great season.
- Can the hidden speed cameras be put out on Autumn Drive? Captain Measimer stated they would try to get those out there.
- Parallel Drive – one resident asked about placing shorter speed bumps on that road that would not impact the larger emergency vehicles.
- Can we get a feature on the website that quickly and easily points citizens to information on projects, grants, etc.?
- 50th Anniversary Celebration – Park staff hit it out of the park. Never heard a single bad thing from anyone about it. Great job.

Town Manager Donham

- Also want to recognize and congratulate Councilmembers Smith and Dellinger on their recent election victories.

Councilmember Smith

- Thank you to Mallory Hodgson for help she recently provided.

Councilmember Patrick

- Thank you to all veterans who have served this country.
- Veteran's Park – military seals placed in the walkway - those may be a little disrespectful and would like to see them moved with any redesign of that area so they are not in a walkway.

Councilmember Dellinger

- To everyone involved in making the 50th Anniversary Celebration take place – thank you. Great job.
- Hickory Ridge paving – very bumpy. Mallory Hodgson stated she has tried to get answers from DOT to no avail.
- Harmony – lack of rain recently is causing an excessive amount of dust with the construction. Can anything be done?
- Anyone who has pumpkins or campaign signs that need recycling can call Ken Huster. He would like to take them.
- Hickory Ridge/Stallings traffic light – are double left turn lanes possible there?
- Recently heard about a trailer park that we supply water to that we are charging commercial rates. Town Manager Donham stated that is not the case. There is a master meter out there and we charge bulk rates. That water is being resold to those residents. They are aware of this as we have talked to many of them before.
- Christmas Angels of Cabarrus County invited Council to their event on December 9th from 1:00pm – 4:00 pm. They provide Christmas gifts to the underprivileged in the community.

PUBLIC HEARING

H-2023-03-TA: UDO text amendment expanding the separation requirement for Tobacco Stores, Vapor Shops, the retail sale of CBD and Hemp-based Products and Electronic Gaming Establishments. Earlier this year the Town Council approved a text amendment (H-2023-01-TA) related to Tobacco Store or Vapor Shop use and the retail sale of CBD and Hemp Based Products. This amendment created definitions for these uses and established a minimum separation requirement of 1,500 linear feet between these uses and the following land use types upon which they may have a negative impact:

- Residentially used property
- Religious institutions
- Public or private elementary or secondary schools
- Cemeteries
- Public parks
- Day Care uses

To ensure consistency with the 2,000 foot separation requirement for “adult” type businesses from each other and “sensitive” land uses, staff is proposing to increase the separation requirement from 1,500 feet to 2,000 feet for Tobacco and/or Vapor Shops, retail sale of Hemp Based Products, and Electronic Gaming Establishments from each other and the land use types noted above. It is the position of staff that increasing this separation requirement is necessary to improve the look and image of the Town and protect certain land use types from negative secondary impacts.

Second was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Price. **The motion passed 7-0.**

The following Consistency Statement was then proposed:

CONSISTENCY STATEMENT:

Based on the staff report and staff presentation, the proposed text amendment is consistent with objective LU-6 (Focus on Quality) of the Harrisburg Area Land Use Plan (HALUP), which recommends that the Town "Improve the appearance of the NC-49 corridor" and it is reasonable and in the public interest.

MOTION:

Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve the Consistency Statement as proposed. Second was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Price. **The motion passed 7-0.**

PUBLIC HEARING

Consider the Town's Water Shortage Response Plan Update. Approximately every five years, or when there are significant changes to the plan, the Town reviews, updates and has Council approve the Water Shortage Response Plan (WSRP). This plan outlines the related public water supplies, the procedures of the Plan, conservation policy, water use classes, drought response triggers and phased water reductions, and enforcement penalties and rates. This plan was last approved in 2018. The plan includes changes per the State's request that a public comment section and variance policy be added.

The State has reviewed the revised plan and approved it accordingly on September 15, 2023.
